# **PRINCIPLES**



## UNIX USER

- In the form of a UUID
- Every user gets a UID
- All gear content is inside the users home directory



- Unique MCS Label
- Keyed off UID
- Determines access to system
- Protects intra-gear shenanigans



#### **CGROUPS**

- Resource Protection
- CPU limits
- Memory Limits
- Overcommit



#### **PAM**

- Using pam limits for process protections
- Using pam\_namespace
- Unique /tmp/ dirs
